Policy Principles:

3. To continuously work towards principles of corporate social responsibility.
4. To increase environmental awareness and responsibility amongst staff and encourage participation in environmental activities, training, and programmes.
5. To work with the local community and other companies to progress environmental initiatives, charity work and exchange best practice.
6. To promote the efficient use of environmental resources (energy, water and raw materials).
7. To reduce waste through elimination, reduction, reuse, and recycling.
8. To promote our sustainable procurement statement.
9. To consider the environmental cost benefit for all new major projects and refurbishments.
10. To promote, encourage and manage travel to minimise the impact on the environment by staff and visitors.
11. To continually monitor, review and publish environmental performance in relation to targets and objectives, and to take appropriate steps to meet them.
